Treasurer's Report

The Society is in a good financial position and substantially all of the expenditure in the year was met from annual subscriptions, donations and ticket sales.

The workshop in February was very popular with 91 attendees, generating a welcome surplus of £490.

The publicity team have collected £272 in advertising income and we have again received generous support from Osborne Clarke with printing of posters, flyers and programmes.

The Society has a healthy surplus on reserves and cash balances of £20,000.

Although an increase to membership subscriptions is not proposed, all members can really help to keep the society financially secure in the future by doing some (or all) of the following:

- promoting membership, concerts and the workshop to all friends and family;
- topping up subscription fees with a donation;
- completing the Gift Aid section of the membership form;
- finding advertisers for the programme;
- buying tickets for the workshop; and
- buying tickets for every concert.
